The morning of April 19th is the Cowboy golf tournament, which sold out in a record 5½ hours this year thanks to the efforts of Sean Rix at State Farm. That evening is the Round-Up kickoff performance and is a patriot theme this year so be sure to wear your red, white & blue. Saturday the 20th is of course the annual rodeo parade, day 2 of the Round-Up and the rodeo concert performance featuring Chase Matthew. Sunday is the conclusion with the Round-Up and the Tough Enough to Wear Pink performance. Tickets are selling fast so don't miss your opportunity.

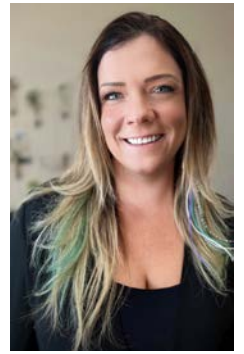

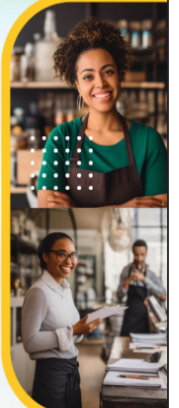
