Round-Up Parade Grand Marshal! A.A. "Red" Emmerson

President & Chairman Emeritus, Sierra Pacific Industries

As the President and Chairman Emeritus, Red Emmerson has given over 70 years of forest products industry leadership to SPI.

Red Bluff

A.A. "Red" Emmerson was born in Grand Ronde, Oregon in 1929, and lived his early years in meager surroundings. In 1948 he graduated high school and moved to join his father in Arcata, California, there he began working in mills and learning as much as he could about every job in the plant.



In 1949, Red and his father formed a partnership (R.H. Emmerson and Son) and went into the lumber business together and built their first sawmill. Under Red's management the company grew, and eventually becoming Sierra Pacific Industries (SPI) in 1969. Red –along with his sons George and Mark – have grown SPI to be one of the nation's leading forest products companies. Today, Red remains active in the company with his sons running the day-to-day operations. Although SPI has experienced tremendous growth, the basic principles of hard work, fair treatment, and commitment to a family atmosphere among employees is still a dominant factor in daily operations of the company.

Today, SPI is a third-generation, family-owned, private business based in Anderson, CA. The company owns 2.4 million acres of timberland in California, Oregon and Washington state, making it the largest privately-held forestland owner in the U.S. Its forestland management is certified under the independent Sustainable Forestry Initiative. With over 6,000 crewmembers across 30 states, SPI is also among the largest U.S. producers of lumber, millwork and wood windows, along with renewable energy production.

The company is also committed to supporting the communities it operates, primarily through the Sierra Pacific Foundation. In 2022, the Foundation gave \$5.3 million to student scholarships, community and educational programs and youth activities.

Attention Parade Route Change

Due to the construction at Madison and Pine Streets, the Round-Up Parade will have a different route this year. It begins as usual at Madison and Oak Streets; It will head east on Oak and turn left at Washington St. It will continue to Walnut Street and turn right the continue to Main Street through Ash Street. The parade will begin at 10 AM, Saturday April 20th and will be one of the largest yet!


