PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Tehama County Opens Eligibility to those 16+

Effective immediately, every Tehama County resident or worker 16 years or older is now eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine. There are no longer any occupational or health-related restrictions for eligibility. Sign up at <https://myturn.ca.gov/> or call (833) 422-4255 and schedule your appointment.

This early timeline is due to an increased vaccine supply from the state and federal governments and increase in appointment availability. We have appointments to fill and by expanding eligibility now, we can ensure that no appointments go unused. We want to make sure that individuals continue to get vaccines as soon as possible.

Tehama County Health Services Agency does anticipate a sharp rise in requests with this additional eligibility and we ask the community to continue to be patient.

We can see the light at the end of the tunnel, but until we get there it is more important than ever for everyone to wear a mask, socially distance, and follow all safety guidelines.

Special Consideration for Minors under the age of 18:

Currently, only the Pfizer vaccine is approved for minors between 16-18 years old. Moderna and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccines are only approved for those 18 and older and will not be administered to minors. When booking an appointment, please verify that it is for the Pfizer vaccine.

Additional requirements for minor's vaccine appointment:

- A parent or guardian must be present at the COVID-19 vaccine appointment
- Government or school issued ID with the minor's date of birth must be presented at the appointment (i.e. driver's license, birth certificate, school ID with birth date on it)

El condado de Tehama abre la elegibilidad para mayores de 16 años

Con efecto inmediato, cada residente o trabajador del condado de Tehama de 16 años o más ahora es elegible para la vacuna contra el COVID-19. Ya no existen restricciones laborales o relacionadas con la salud para la elegibilidad. Regístrese en <https://myturn.ca.gov/> o llame al (833) 422-4255 y programe su cita.

Este periodo acelerado se debe a un mayor suministro de vacunas de los gobiernos estatal y federal y al aumento de la disponibilidad de citas. Tenemos citas para llenar y al aumentar la elegibilidad ahora, podemos asegurarnos de que ninguna cita quede sin usar. Queremos asegurarnos de que las personas continúen recibiendo las vacunas lo antes posible.

La Agencia de Servicios de Salud del Condado de Tehama anticipa un aumento en las solicitudes con este aumento de elegibilidad y le pedimos a la comunidad que continúe siendo paciente.

Podemos ver la luz al final del túnel, pero hasta que lleguemos allí es más importante que nunca que todos usen una mascarilla, distancian físicamente, y sigan todas las pautas de seguridad.

Consideraciones especiales para menores de 18 años:

Actualmente, solo la vacuna Pfizer está aprobada para menores de entre 16 y 18 años. Las vacunas Moderna y Johnson & Johnson/Janssen solo están aprobadas para personas mayores de 18 años y no se administrarán a menores. Al reservar una cita, verifique que sea para la vacuna Pfizer.

Requisitos adicionales para la cita de vacunación de menores de edad:

- Un padre o guardián legal debe estar presente en la cita para la vacuna contra el COVID-19.
- En la cita se debe presentar una identificación emitida por el gobierno o la escuela con la fecha de nacimiento del menor (es decir, licencia de conducir, certificado de nacimiento, identificación de la escuela con la fecha de nacimiento)
